

# Athletic Uniform Care Instructions

All uniforms must be properly handled while washing and drying so uniforms will last for several years. Failure to do so may result in paying for a replacement.

Please use these instructions while washing / drying:

- Machine wash cold
- Wash with like colors
- Do not use Fabric Softener, it will cause printed cloth patterns to separate from material.
- Do not use chlorine bleach as the chance of color separation and the weakening of some material is increased
- Wash uniforms inside out to protect numbering and lettering
- Hang-dry uniforms only, DO NOT put in the dryer
- Do not dry clean
- Do not iron

This form assigns primary responsibility for Heritage Christian Academy athletic equipment to the borrower. The borrower will be responsible for taking the necessary precautions to protect the equipment and to store it in a manner that provides adequate protection when it is not in use, thus not subjecting the equipment to possible theft or damage.

1. All athletic equipment that has been signed for, in both the traditional and non-traditional seasons, must be returned in satisfactory condition immediately following:
  - a. The final date of practice or
  - b. The final contest or
  - c. The date the student-athlete is no longer a member of the official team roster, whichever is earliest.
2. If loss or damage of the equipment/property occurs and determination is made that the loss or damage is a result of negligence, the borrower will be held financially responsible for the repair or replacement of the item(s).
3. Equipment cannot be loaned or transferred to a third party.
4. The borrower cannot modify the equipment in any way without written approval of the athletic office.

The borrower will make the equipment available at any time as requested by the athletic office.
