Community

Heritage Christian Academy (HCA) is a 42 acre campus located on Quail Run Dr. just off 9th St. in Oshtemo Township in the Kalamazoo Public School district. The school serves families from 60 different churches in the greater Kalamazoo Area. Admission requires that at least one parent or guardian has a personal testimony of faith in Jesus Christ and is in agreement with the school's Statement of Faith.

School

Heritage Christian Academy has a PreK-12 program with a total enrollment of 207 students. We also have a learning lab that provides Educational Therapy, along with other services to students with learning challenges. The school opened in the fall of 1989 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 1994. Heritage Christian Academy is accredited by Advanced Ed and the Association of Christian Schools International.

Curriculum

Our Secondary School (7-12th grades) is organized into two semesters with a 2 week January term (J-term) between the semesters. During J-term students take four 1 week elective courses that are taught in a block schedule format. Our middle school students (7th and 8th grades) take math, science, English, social studies, Bible, computer, physical education and health. Middle school students also chose between the electives of art, band, choir and yearbook.
